1) Public Comment – Malarkey commented on distributing pricing, sales approach, and the pay scale for contractors moving to employee status.

2) Review of Minutes

a) Regular board meeting minutes from November 10, 2010 were reviewed and Caffrey motioned to approve the minutes, Plionis seconded, and Nunez abstained, vote carried. Special meeting minutes from December 1, 2010 were reviewed and Caffrey motioned to approve the minutes, Plionis seconded, vote carried.

- a) Financial Statements Coady presented financial statements: Profit & Loss November 2010, Balance Sheet as of November 30, 2010, Statement of Cash Flows November 2010, and Budget vs. Actual YTD (see 3a.i, 3a.ii, 3a.ii, 3a.ii, 3a.iv attached).
- b) Proposed Budget Amendments Coady presented a Pro Forma and Cash Flow Projections for FY2011 to complement the proposed operating budget amendments (see 3b attached). Nunez motioned to approve the amended budget reflecting actuals through November 2010, Caffrey seconded, motion carried unanimously.

- a) Project and Sales Status Report Pascaretti presented a handout with an overview of project status and sales (see 4a **attached**).
- b) Pat explained that a decision should be made in regards to moving payroll to Northampton County for January 1, 2011. The board chose to discuss this in more detail in closed session.

- d) Caffrey motioned to move existing ESVBA employees to Northampton County's Payroll January 1, 2011, Plionis seconded, the vote carried.
