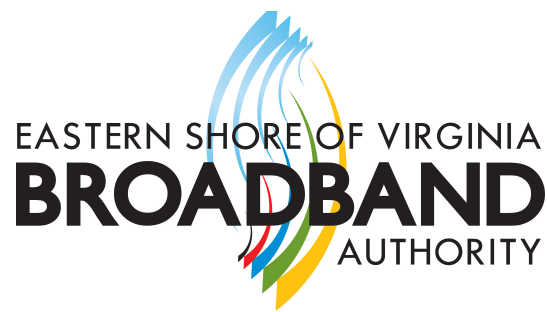
Response to Queries
